EXPLORE Writing Utensils

Gather a variety of writing utensils (markers, crayons, pencils, etc.). Also gather different types of paper to write on. Allow your child to explore writing or making marks on the papers with the utensils. Talk about the Bible story (reverse side). Remind your child that people wrote God's words and those words are in the Bible.

MAKE FACES

Ask your child to make an angry face. Explain: "The king was very angry at the words Jeremiah and Baruch wrote on the scroll."

Make a happy face. Ask your child if you are happy or sad. Tell him that Jeremiah was happy to write the words again after the king tore up the scroll. Remind your child that people in the Bible told about God.

BABIES

MOVE BLOCKS

Print on separate strips of masking tape: *The, Bible, is, from, God.* Put the tape strips on separate blocks. Provide two plastic bowls. Put the blocks in one of the bowls. Invite your baby to play an in and out game. Guide your baby to move the blocks from one bowl to the other. Say the words as the blocks are moved. Line up the words in the correct order. Point to and say each word. Remark: "People wrote God's words in the Bible."

Jeremiah Wrote God's Words

BASED ON JEREMIAH 36

WEEKLY VERSE: All that the Bible says is from God. *2 Timothy 3:16*

LIFE POINT: People wrote God's words in the Bible.



BABIES

Jeremiah listened to God.
Jeremiah told his helper to write down the words God told Jeremiah.
The king heard the words on the scroll and cut up the scroll.
Jeremiah had his helper write the words again on another scroll.

1s

God told Jeremiah to get a scroll and write the words He told him.
Jeremiah told his helper God's words to write on the scroll.
Then Jeremiah's helper, Baruch, read the scroll at the temple (church).
The king heard the words and cut up the scroll.
Jeremiah and Baruch wrote the words again on another scroll.

2s

God told Jeremiah to help people know they should stop doing things that were not right.
God told Jeremiah: "Write on a scroll the words I have told you about the people. Then maybe they will change and do what is right."
Jeremiah told his helper, Baruch, the words from God to write on the scroll.
Baruch read the scroll at the temple (church) to the people.
The words on the scroll were read to the king. The king got mad and cut up the scroll.
Jeremiah and Baruch wrote the words again on another scroll.
