REMINDE Your Child

Say: "God is always with us," as you go to different places with your child this week. Take a moment as you enter the grocery store or day care to comment: "God is with us. He will take care of us." As you cuddle your child before bed, look at the Bible story picture (reverse side) together and talk about the Bible story. State the Unit Verse. Pray: "Thank You, God, for always being with us."

Go on a WALK

Take your child for a walk in your neighborhood. Talk about the homes you see and the people who live there. Lead your child to wave hello to a neighbor. After the walk show the Bible story picture and tell the Bible story. Mention that some of the people were afraid to move to a new home, but Joshua and Caleb said, "God is with us. He will take care of us."



BABIES

Moses chose Joshua, Caleb, and 10 men to go look at the promised land from God.
