



## GATHER and FEED

Draw a simple boat shape on a sheet of paper. Place your child in a high chair. Tape the boat drawing onto the tray or table in front of your child. Offer some animal toys. Mention that God told Noah to put animals on the ark. Lead your child to put the animals on the ark you drew. Offer a dry snack like O-shaped cereal. State that God told Noah to put food on the ark. Lead your child to put some food on the ark you drew. Comment that God took care of Noah and the animals.

### BABIES

#### PLAN the Day

Talk about the plan you have for that day as you dress your child in the morning. Remark that God told Noah to build an ark (a big boat). Say that God has a plan for the world, too.

#### FILL an ARK

Offer a large basket or box and toy animals to your child. Suggest your child pretend that the basket is the ark. Lead your child to put the animals in the ark. Help your child to sit in the basket. Gently push the basket around the room. Show the Bible story picture (reverse side) and talk about the Bible story. Mention that God took care of Noah, his family, and the animals.

God put a rainbow in the sky as a sign to Noah.

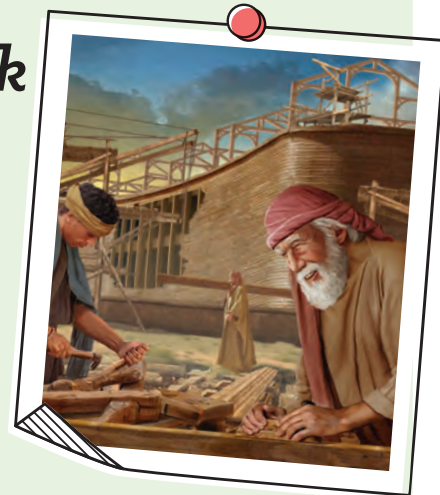
### 2s

Noah and his family loved and obeyed God. God told Noah to build an ark (a big boat) with many rooms. God said He would flood (cover with water) the earth.

Noah built the ark. Noah put food for the animals and his family in the ark. Noah, his family, and the animals went in the ark. God closed the door.

Rain fell for 40 days. The rain stopped, and the land dried. Noah, his family, and the animals came out of the ark. Noah thanked God.

God put a rainbow in the sky as a reminder that He would not flood the whole earth again.
