BASED ON NUMBERS 13-14

WEEKLY VERSE: God said, "I will always love you." *Jeremiah 31:3*

LIFE POINT: God loves people even when they make wrong choices.

God promised the people a new home in the land of Canaan. God told Moses to choose 12 men to travel and look at the land. Joshua and Caleb were two of the men.

The 12 men traveled into Canaan. They saw the people and towns. They cut a branch with a bunch of grapes. Two men carried the grapes on a pole between them. The men also gathered other fruit from the land. After 40 days, the men went back to the people.

The men said to the people, "The land of Canaan is good for growing food. Look at some of the fruit." The men showed the people the grapes and other fruit.

Ten men said, "The towns have tall walls around them. The people are stronger than we are." The people became frightened and angry.

Joshua and Caleb said, "We looked at the land. The land is a good place to live. God will give the land to us."

The people shouted and cried. They did not want to go into the land or do what God said. They chose to disobey God. God told Moses the people would stay in the wilderness for 40 years.
